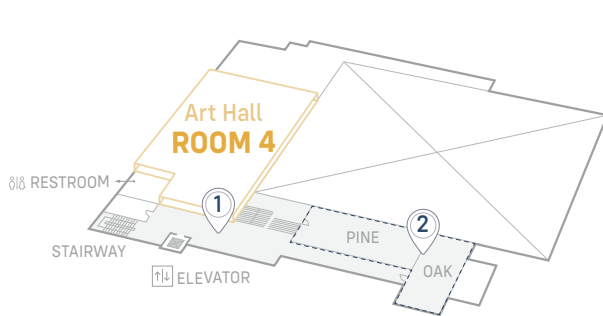

Floor Plan

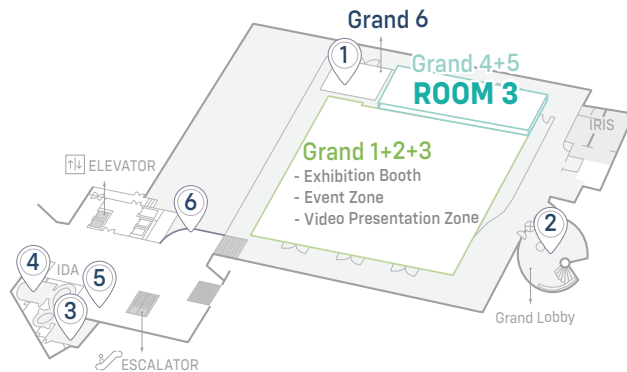

Study design a. VISION was a phase 2, single-arm, open-label, multicenter, nonrandomized clinical trial of tepotinib in patients with METex14-skipping advanced/metastatic NSCLC (cohorts A and C). This LFTU of VISION study was conducted to assess long-term efficacy and safety of tepotinib (Median follow-up was 32.6 months). 313 patients with advanced EGFRALK wild-type and METex14-skipping NSCLC detected by tissue (Tb) and/or liquid biopsy (Lb) received tepotinib 500mg (450mg active moiety) once daily. Data cutoff was November 20, 2022. The primary end point was objective response by independent review committee (RECIST v1.1).

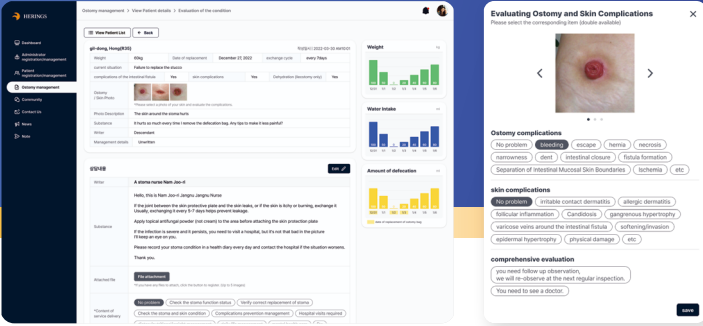

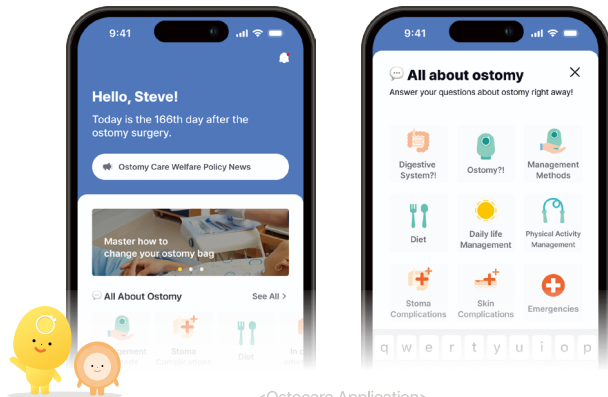

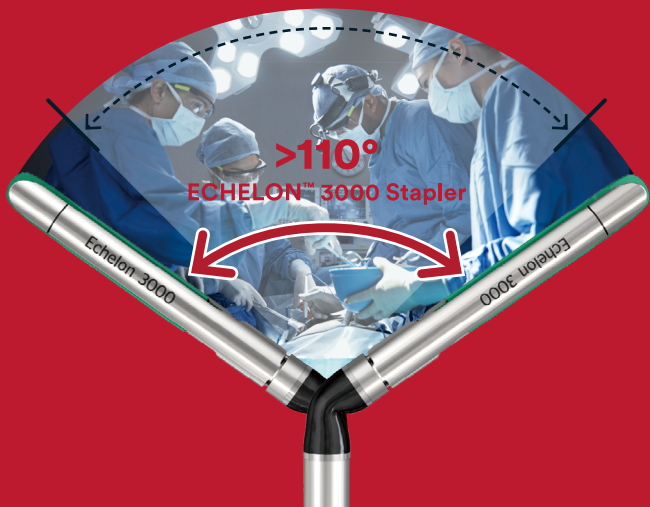
